Parent Code of Conduct

All Parents /Guardians of registered players participating in the ADCA Junior Competition must, at all times, show respect to, and understanding for, the safety and welfare of others.

Penalties will apply for any breach of the Parent Code of Conduct.

1st Breach – Official warning issued

2nd Breach – Suspension from attendance at games

(attendance in this instance means maintaining a distance from the team which prevents any interaction with the players, parents and officials)

As a Parent/Guardian of a Player (member) you MUST abide by the following Code of Conduct:

- Adhere to the Rules and Playing Conditions as set by the ADCA JSC.
- Show respect to all Coaches, Scorers, Team Managers, Parents, and Players.
- Respect the Umpire's decision at all times.
- Work equally hard for yourself and for your team. Your Team's performance will benefit and so will you.
- **Be a good sport.** Applaud all good play whether made by your player's team or the opposition.
- Show respect to and acknowledge all Opponents and Officials.
- Play fair. No verbal abuse of officials or players including vilification, will be tolerated.
- **Respect the rights, dignity and worth of ALL participants** regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background, or religion. Bullying, in any shape or form, of any person at any time will not be tolerated.
